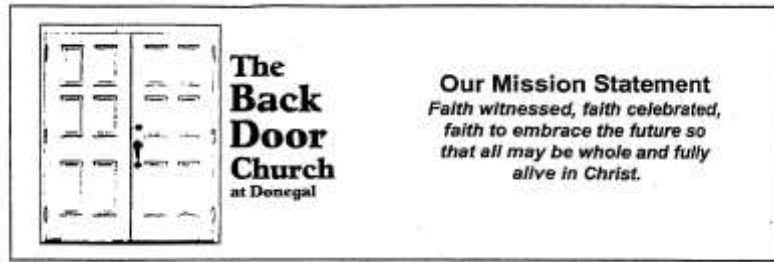

Reflection for the Christian Life

Both of our scripture lessons, Psalm 115 and Joshua 24:14-15, reference idols. An idol can be seen as some “other god” that is worshiped instead of the God of Israel. However, an idol can be much more than that. An idol can be anything in our lives that we hold in a higher regard than our God... money... material possessions... sports... television programming... the list could be endless. The hard fact is that there could even be things associated with the church that could be seen as an idol. So what in your life or in our life together can possibly be seen as an idol? How do we respond to Joshua's exhortation as God's beloved children? “Choose this day whom you will serve... but as for me and my household, we will serve the LORD.”
