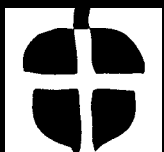

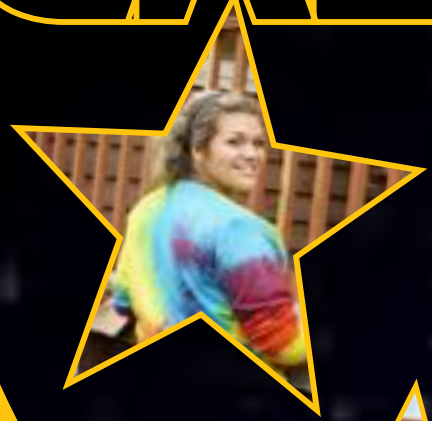

BASE CAMP AND TRACKS

Base Camp (2nd-12th Grade)

Who knew you could fit so much fun and excitement into one week? Donegal's base camp is more exciting than ever and the best way to experience the traditional overnight camp atmosphere. The camp gives you a sample of what Donegal has to offer, including beloved experiences and new opportunities. When registering for base camp, campers will select which track they want to participate in (see descriptions below).

TRACKS

Imagination - For campers who love to use their imagination! This track is designed for campers to develop creativity while experiencing outdoor activities at camp. Throughout the summer, volunteers will teach campers drama, fabric arts, drawing and sketching. Art-loving campers can enjoy the outdoors too!

Sampler - Do you love arts and crafts and extreme activities? This track is for you! This track is designed for campers who love to use their imagination and participate in hands-on activities. Dip your toes into both walks of life by participating...you won't regret it!

Water - This track is designed for campers who love extreme games and water activities. This track combines exciting games and water events such as swimming and slip and slide. Cool off during the summer by signing up for this track.

PRICING

This year, Camp Donegal is once again utilizing tiered pricing. The idea behind it is simple: Summer camp has great value in the life of a child. At Camp Donegal, we want to enable any child or youth who wants to come to camp to do so - regardless of financial ability or uncertainty. Camp Donegal works hard to keep camp affordable. However, as with most other aspects of life, the costs to run a quality camp are constantly on the rise. This pricing does not influence the quality of the camp experience for any child attending camp.

TIER 1: Does not reflect the true cost of operating our summer camp programs but is available to ensure that no camper gets left behind. This tier relies heavily on Presbytery subsidy and donations to cover the remaining expenses.

TIER 2: Allows us to offset some of our expenses, but results in less revenue than needed to maintain a balanced budget and continue improving the camper experience.

TIER 3: More closely accounts for the true costs of camp.

We appreciate any family or individual who would like to donate beyond their tier's pricing. Although it is up to you to decide what you can afford to pay toward your child's camp experience, please consider selecting the highest price your family is able to afford. By doing so, you'll not only help cover the true cost of running camp, but also protect every child's opportunity to meet Christ at camp!

SPECIALTY CAMPS

NIGHT OWLS 5TH-12TH GRADE

If waking up at 7:30am does not sound like fun, sign up for our Night Owl camp! This program is designed so that campers get to experience all the wonders of Donegal in the DARK! Campers will sleep thru the day and wake up with the owls to play! This program is designed for campers who love to stay up late and play under the stars!

C.I.T. 10TH-12TH GRADE

This program is for high school students who are interested in being a counselor. The first week, campers will learn leadership skills and participate in fun camp games! The second week, campers will shadow a counselor and have first-hand experience of the amount of work that goes into being a counselor. During session one, campers will travel to Creation Festival at Mt. Union, PA, where they will volunteer and see some of the top performers. Submit a recommendation from someone in your church and a one-page response on why you would like to be a part of our CIT program. You must attend CIT Week 1 in order to attend Week 2. If fewer than six students enroll, this program will be held at Krislund.

ROCK, RAFT AND ROLL 6TH-12TH GRADE

Want to experience white water rafting down the Ohiopyle, biking the Great Allegheny Passage, and rock climbing? Campers will experience the ultimate adventure camp that will include a three-day, two-night camping trip off site. Sleep under the stars, battle the rapids, and become better climbers in one week!



SPECIALTY CAMPS



SURVIVOR 5TH-12TH GRADE

I'm a survivor...wait this isn't a Beyonce song... this camp is for campers who are ready to conquer fire building, camp under the stars, learn first aid, and other outdoor skills. Campers will be pushed and tested to see if they can perform different challenges and survive with the resources given to them. Sign up today if you are ready to prove you can make it!

SCUBA CAMP 12 YRS AND OLDER

Dive down under with this camp. Campers will work with a certified Scuba instructor to have the opportunity to get the PADI Scuba Certification. Scuba certification teaches you how to dive and pushes you beyond your comfort level. Campers will work in the Krislund pool and travel to the Susquehanna River for open dives toward certification. This camp will be held at Krislund.

CANADA TRIP 8TH-12TH GRADE

Do you love extreme adventure? Come with us to Canada and experience whitewater rafting, hiking, camping, and whitewater kayaking in this 7-day experience on the world class Ottawa River. Campers will learn basic skills and then travel to the beautiful forests of Canada for their extreme adventure experience.

This trip will be led by our Executive Director, Gene Joiner, class IV paddler and extreme adventurer. This camp is designed for campers who love heart pounding, blood rushing experiences! This camp will be held at Krislund. (Campers must have a passport)

DAY CAMP

We know that finding childcare during the summer can be stressful - so we are here to help! Day Camp is the perfect way to get your child engaged with the outdoors and make new friends. Day Camp offers campers the opportunity to be a camper during the day and go home at night. Campers will go hiking, make crafts, play extreme games, and explore the creek. Donegal is offering Day Camp for campers who have completed K-8th grade. Each week, the Bible Study curriculum will be different but will focus on who Jesus is and how we can share our story with others. Sign up one week or multiple weeks!

DAY CAMP FAQ'S

Q: What are the ala carte options available for Day Camp

A: Campers may add swimming lessons and Thursday night overnight.

Q: Must I be Presbyterian to attend?

A: No! Our campers represent a wide variety of denominations and our camp is open to youth with no church affiliation. All campers will participate in daily Bible studies and camp-style worship led by our staff and a volunteer chaplain each week.

Q: Can you accommodate campers with special needs?

A: Please call the Donegal Office to discuss any special requirements for your camper.

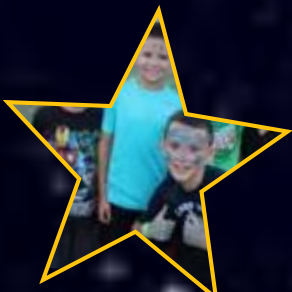
Q: Can my child be in the same group as a friend?

A: Campers may register to be in the same group with one other friend. Please call the Donegal office to make your request.

Q: What should my camper bring each day?

A: We have a full packing list located at www.campdonegal.org or call the Donegal office for more information.

FAQ'S



Q: Can my child be in the same group as a friend?

A: Campers may register to be in the same lodging with one other friend. Both campers must request to be bunk mates when they register.

Q: What about friends during the day? Can they stay together?

A: If campers sign up for the same activity track (see page 5), they will be together for all activities, including the morning activities. If they choose different tracks, they will be together for afternoon and evening activities. All bunkmates will be on the same Alpha or Omega team. Housing will be in age-appropriate groupings.

Q: What are the starting and ending times for camp each week?

A: Camp registration is held on Sunday from 4-5pm. On Friday, the closing program begins at 4:45pm and campers leave immediately afterward.

Q: Are scholarships available?

A: Many local churches provide financial help to youth from their congregations and communities who wish to attend camp. If you need financial aid, contact your church. If the local church is unable to respond, contact the camp office. Camp Donegal has limited scholarship funds to assist youth unable to secure financial help from their churches.

Q: Must I be Presbyterian to attend?

A: No! Our campers represent a wide variety of denominations and our camp is open to youth with no church affiliation. All campers will participate in daily Bible studies and camp-style worship led by our staff and a volunteer chaplain each week.
